

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where is packet pick-up?

Packet pick-up is at the High School. The address for the High School is 400 East Maple

What time is packet pick-up?

Packet pick-up begins on Friday, February 11th - 4 PM to 9 PM

Saturday, February 12th – 10 AM to 9 PM

Sunday, February 13th schedule is as follows:

42k – 6:30 AM to 7:30 AM

58k, 35k and Vasa Relay – 6:30 AM to 8:30 AM

13k – 6:30 AM to 11:00 AM

Where are the buses located that take skiers to the start area?

The buses leave from the High School.

What times do the buses leave?

The bus schedule is as follows:

42k – 7 AM to 8AM

58k, 35k & Vasa Relay – 8 AM to 9 AM

13k – 10:45 AM to 11:45 AM

What time do the races begin?

The start of the races begin at different times according to which race. The schedule is as follows:

42k – 9 AM

58k, 35k and Vasa Relay – 10 AM

13k – 12:30 PM

When is the latest I can register?

Online and fax registration are taken until 3 PM on Saturday, February 12th. Walk-ins are taken at Vasaloppet Headquarters, 100 South Union, until 9 PM on Saturday, February 12th.

THERE ARE NO RACE DAY REGISTRATIONS.

How do skiers get to the start area?

*All skiers are urged to take advantage of free bus service from the High School to the start of the races. It is **strongly** recommended that skiers use the buses provided to the start area as transportation back to the start is not provided after the finish of the race.*

Skiers can have someone drive them up to the start area for the beginning of the race and spectators are allowed to watch the start of the race. There are no spectator buses provided.

Are there cut-off times?

*Skiers passing the designated markers, located at Soup Stop 3/D, after 2 p.m., Soup Stop E, after 3:00 p.m., or Soup Stop 4/F, after 4:00 p.m. **WILL BE PULLED FROM THE RACE COURSE.** Transportation back to the finish line will be provided.*

What is the date, time, cost and distances for the Moraloppet?

The Moraloppet will be on Saturday, February 5th at 1 PM. The cost is \$10 and there is a 7km and 14km race. It is a timed race and a dala horse award is given out to the first male and first female finisher in both races. Ribbons are also given out for age classes. It is held up at the Nordic Center Complex and you can register when you arrive.
